

# MSF30422 Certificate III in Glass and Glazing

(Apprenticeship)

## Description

This qualification reflects the role of individuals involved in manufacturing, processing, moving or installing various types of glass products. Job roles may be in glass processing or glazing in both residential and commercial operations.

## Job Roles/Employment Outcomes

Workers use a range of technical knowledge to perform skilled work involving known routines, methods and procedures. They use discretion and judgement to adapt and transfer their skills and knowledge to different job needs and take responsibility for their own work within organisational parameters.

## Pathways into the Qualification

Credit can be granted towards this qualification by those who have completed MSF20422 Certificate II in Glass and Glazing.

## Pathways from the Qualification

Further training pathways from this qualification may include 'Furnishing' Certificate IV or Diploma qualifications and relevant supervisory, management or competitive manufacturing qualifications.

## Duration of this Qualification

3 year Apprenticeship.

## Cost of this Qualification

This qualification is directly aligned with priority industry areas where jobs are today, and into the future. As part of the state government Lower fees, local skills program, through to 31 December 2025 you will only pay half the tuition fees (plus resource fee) capped at \$1,200; or \$400 if you are aged 15-24 or eligible for a concession.
